

Florence, 14 October 2009

**DRAFT BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE SECOND MEETING OF UNISCAPE's  
GENERAL ASSEMBLY, Malmö (Sweden), 7 October 2009**

**The General Assembly approved:**

1. the List of decisions adopted by the *General Assembly* on the occasion of its first meeting (Villa Medicea, Florence, Italy, 12 July 2008).
2. the La Rábida Declaration for raising awareness and the training of specialists in landscape protection, management and planning (*La Rábida, Andalucía, Spain, 14 – 16 May 2009*).
3. UNISCAPE's 2008 balance sheet.
4. a draft membership regulation indicating the terms for the payment of the annual financial contribution and the ending membership of those that will not have paid this fee by 1 January 2010.

**With regard to UNISCAPE activities and initiatives, the General Assembly took note of and agreed on the following proposals:**

1. Florence + 10: to organise jointly with LANDSCAPE EUROPE a UNISCAPE scientific conference in occasion of the 10th anniversary of the opening of the European Landscape Convention for signature.
2. To develop a joint strategy with regard to landscape master classes.
3. To publish the: "Landscape as a project. European universities in debate" containing the answers of representatives of UNISCAPE member universities on an enquiry drafted by Professor Franco Zagari.
4. To develop an extensive bibliography on landscape available on the website and create a glossary of landscape definitions.
5. To support and publicise a photo competition regarding the landscape as perceived by people in order to involve students of UNISCAPE members.

**The General Assembly expressed the will to:**

Cooperate with the Council of Europe and its organs.  
Cooperate with other networks interested in landscape.  
Cooperate with RECEP-ENELC and CIVILSCAPE.

The third meeting of UNISCAPE's General Assembly will be in Florence in occasion of Florence +10 in October 2010.
